1. All participants will be provided with 1 white A4 art card which must be used. It can be reduced in size and altered in color. Those required to make envelopes must bring their own paper or card for the same.
2. As this is an on-the-spot competition, pre-done and pre-prepared work will be observed by the organizers and pointed out to the judges and can be penalized. Reference to sketches is allowed.
3. All materials to be brought by the participant.
4. Choice of medium & technique is at the participants' discretion.
5. Paint must be dry by the end of the permitted time.
6. **Participant's names should not be written on the card or displayed in any manner whatsoever.**
7. Participants exceeding time limit will be penalized not disqualified.
8. Cards or any other items not collected on the 18<sup>th</sup> October 2014 shall be disposed off by the organizers and the organizers or any member of the Oshwal Youth League shall hold no responsibility of the same.
9. **This event is Open to All.** (Participants from all communities and backgrounds are permitted to participate)
10. All exhibits are at participants' risk throughout the viewing and if not collected at the stated time.
11. Organizers reserve right to ask for proof of age (a birth certificate **MUST** be provided).
12. Judges and organizers' decision is final.

# RANGOLI COMPETITION

AGES	TIME ALLOWED	SIZE
6-9	4½ hours	1 ½' by 1 ½' '
9-12	4½ hours	2' by 2'
12-15	4½ hours	2 ½' by 2 ½''
15-18	4½ hours	2 ½' by 2 ½'
18 years and above	4½ hours	3' by 3'

1. A maximum of two participants per entry is permitted and both must fall within that age category. If there is one participant who falls in an elder category, the entire team will be judged in the older category. (E.g. If a participant is 7years old and his/her partner is 10years, they will fall under the 9-12year category and not the 6-9years category)
2. Choice of medium is at participants' discretion.
3. Freehand and dots Rangoli **will not be** separately categorized.
4. Circular Rangoli must fit into the square space. (The diameter should be the size as mentioned in the table above according to category.( E.g. 6-9years would use a diameter of 1 ½' )
5. **No Stencils, Not even Dots Stencils are allowed for Rangoli.**
6. Those doing Circular or Odd shaped rangoli will have to accept the state of the floor.
7. All materials for Rangoli to be brought by the participants.
8. Participants are allowed to carry their own boards. Boards should be the exact size of the space allocated. No pre done drawing on the board will be allowed, this shall result into the board being confiscated (Such boards will be returned to the participant at the end of the event). The Oshwal youth league shall **NOT** provide boards.
9. Strictly no drawing of designs allowed during *Lipan* time, this will be disqualified.
10. Participants exceeding time limit will be penalized not disqualified.
11. Ensure that the rangoli has a border (bandheli).
12. Additional décor will not be considered when judging.
13. Rangoli Colors, Additional Decorations or any other items not collected on the 18<sup>th</sup> October 2014 shall be disposed off by the organizers and the organizers or any member of the Oshwal Youth League shall hold no responsibility of the same.
14. All exhibits are at participants' risk throughout the viewing and if items are not collected at the stated time.
15. **Participant's names should not be written around/on the rangoli or displayed in any manner whatsoever.**
16. **This event is Open to All.** (Participants from all communities and backgrounds are permitted to participate)
17. Organizers reserve right to ask for proof of age (a birth certificate **MUST** be provided).
18. Judges and organizers' decision is final.

# **POT DECORATION COMPETITION**

<b>AGES</b>	<b>TIME ALLOWED</b>
<b>12-15</b>	4 hours
<b>15-18</b>	4 hours
<b>18 years and above</b>	4 hours

1. A Pot will be provided and should be decorated ON THE SPOT using any combination of materials, media, accessories etc.
2. The pot size is: Base Diameter - 17½cm, Height - 27½cm and top diameter – 27cm (This is an approximate size; the actual size of the pot may vary slightly).
3. All participants must assemble on **10<sup>th</sup> October 2014** at **Visa Oshwal Mahajanwadi** between **6:00pm to 8:00pm** for base coat.
4. Any additional work done during the base coat period will be disqualified.
5. NO STENSILS OF ANY KIND SHOULD BE USED.
6. Participants exceeding time limit will be penalized not disqualified.
7. As this is an on-the-spot competition, pre-done and pre-prepared work will be observed by the organizers and pointed out to the judges and can be penalized. Reference to sketches is allowed.
8. All materials should be brought by the participants.
9. All paint effects must dry by the end of the time allowed.
10. Pots, Decorations or any other items not collected on the 18<sup>th</sup> October 2014 shall be disposed off by the organizers and the organizers or any member of the Oshwal Youth League shall hold no responsibility of the same.
11. All pots are at the participants' risk throughout the viewing of the exhibition and if not collected at the stated time.
- 12. Participant's names should not be written on the pot or displayed in any manner whatsoever.**
13. **This event is Open to All.** (Participants from all communities and backgrounds are permitted to participate)
14. Organizers reserve right to ask for proof of age (a birth certificate MUST be provided).
15. Judges and organizers' decision is final.

# CANDLE DECORATING COMPETITION

AGES	TIME ALLOWED
12-15	3 hours
15-18	3 hours
18 years and above	3 hours

1. All participants will be provided with a cylindrical candle of size: Height – 20cm and Diameter – 7cm (This size is an approximate; the actual candle size may vary slightly).
2. As this is an on-the-spot competition, pre-done and pre-prepared work will be observed by the organizers and pointed out to the judges and can be penalized. Reference to sketches is allowed.
3. All materials to be brought by the participant.
4. Choice of medium & technique is at the participants' discretion.
5. Paint must be dry by the end of the permitted time.
6. Candles should not have a burnt wick nor should it be lighted.
7. **Participant's names should not be written on the candle or displayed in any manner whatsoever.**
8. Participants exceeding time limit will be penalized not disqualified.
9. Candles or any other items not collected on the 18<sup>th</sup> October 2014 shall be disposed off by the organizers and the organizers or any member of the Oshwal Youth League shall hold no responsibility of the same.
10. **Open to all.**
11. All exhibits are at participants' risk throughout the viewing and if not collected at the stated time.
12. Organizers reserve right to ask for proof of age (a birth certificate MUST be provided).
13. Judges and organizers' decision is final.

# GLASS PAINTING COMPETITION

AGES	TIME ALLOWED	SIZE
15-18	3 hours	8.5inch x 8.5inch
18 years and above	3 hours	8.5inch x 8.5inch

1. Glass of size **8.5inch x 8.5inch** will be provided to all participants and should be decorated ON THE SPOT using any combination of materials, media, accessories etc..
2. As this is an on-the-spot competition, pre-done and pre-prepared work will be observed by the organizers and pointed out to the judges. Reference to sketches is allowed.
3. **NO STENSILS OF ANY KIND SHOULD BE USED.**
4. Participants exceeding time limit will be penalized not disqualified.
5. Additional décor will not be considered when judging.
6. All materials should be brought by the participants.
7. **Participant's names should not be written on the glass or displayed in any manner whatsoever.**
8. All paintings are at the participants' risk throughout the viewing of the exhibition and if not collected at the stated time.
9. Glass painting, Additional Decorations, or any other items not collected on the 18<sup>th</sup> October 2014 shall be disposed off by the organizers and the organizers or any member of the Oshwal Youth League shall hold no responsibility of the same.
10. **OPEN TO ALL**
11. Organizers reserve right to ask for proof of age (a birth certificate MUST be provided).
12. Judges and organizers' decision is final.

# **GENERAL RULES**

1. All participants must be available on time, no additional time would be provided for any reason whatsoever.
2. All certificates **MUST** be collected before or on the day of dismantling – 18<sup>th</sup> October 2014. After this the Conveners or any member of the Oshwal Youth League shall take no responsibility of the certificates.
3. The Judges Decision Shall be final in all categories.

- Relevance to theme
- Creativity
- Originality
- Neatness
- Clarity of idea and image
- Use of color
- Use of space

### **Visual Interest**

- Use of Elements of Art
  - (Color, Value, Line, Shape, Form, Texture, Space)
- Use of Principles of Design
  - (Balance, Contrast, Emphasis, Movement, Pattern, Rhythm, Unity)

### **Content**

- Originality
  - (Unique, Fresh, Interesting)
- Classical/Traditional
  - (Enduring the test of time.)
- Communicative
  - (Thought Provoking, Meaningful, Expressive)
