- 1. All participants will be provided with 1 white A4 art card which must be used. It can be reduced in size and altered in color. Those required to make envelopes must bring their own paper or card for the same.
- 2. As this is an on-the-spot competition, pre-done and pre-prepared work will be observed by the organizers and pointed out to the judges and can be penalized. Reference to sketches is allowed.
- 3. All materials to be brought by the participant.
- 4. Choice of medium & technique is at the participants' discretion.
- 5. Paint must be dry by the end of the permitted time.
- 6. Participant's names should not be written on the card or displayed in any manner whatsoever.
- 7. Participants exceeding time limit will be penalized not disqualified.
- 8. Cards or any other items not collected on the 7th November 2015 shall be disposed off by the organizers and the organizers or any member of the Oshwal Youth League shall hold no responsibility of the same.
- **9.** This event is Open to All. (Participants from all communities and backgrounds are permitted to participate)
- 10. All exhibits are at participants' risk throughout the viewing and if not collected at the stated time.
- 11. Organizers reserve right to ask for proof of age (a birth certificate **MUST** be provided).
- 12. Judges and organizers' decision is final.

RANGOLI COMPETITION

AGES	TIME ALLOWED	SIZE
6-9	4½ hours	1 ½' by 1 ½ '
9-12	4½ hours	2' by 2'
12-15	4½ hours	2 ½' by 2 ½'
15-18	4½ hours	2 ½' by 2 ½'
18 years and above	4½ hours	3' by 3'

- 1. A maximum of two participants per entry is permitted and both must fall within that age category. If there is one participant who falls in an elder category, the entire team will be judged in the older category. (E.g. If a participant is 7years old and his/her partner is 10years, they will fall under the 9-12year category and not the 6-9years category)
- 2. Lipan is to be done by the participant(s) only, no-one else can assist.
- 3. Choice of medium is at participants' discretion.
- 4. Freehand and dots Rangoli will not be separately categorized.
- 5. Circular Rangoli must fit into the square space. (The diameter should be the size as mentioned in the table above according to category. (E.g. 6-9years would use a diameter of $1 \frac{1}{2}$)
- 6. No Stencils, Not even Dots Stencils are allowed for Rangoli.
- 7. Those doing Circular or Odd shaped rangoli will have to accept the state of the floor.
- 8. All materials for Rangoli to be brought by the participants.
- 9. Participants are allowed to carry their own boards. Boards should be the exact size of the space allocated. No pre done drawing on the board will be allowed, this shall result into the board being confiscated (Such boards will be returned to the participant at the end of the event). The Oshwal youth league shall **NOT** provide boards.
- 10. Strictly no drawing of designs allowed during *Lipan* time, this will be disqualified.
- 11. Participants exceeding time limit will be penalized not disqualified.
- 12. Ensure that the rangoli has a border (bandheli).
- 13. Additional décor will not be considered when judging.
- 14. Rangoli Colors, Additional Decorations or any other items not collected on the 7th November 2015 shall be disposed off by the organizers and the organizers or any member of the Oshwal Youth League shall hold no responsibility of the same.
- 15. All exhibits are at participants' risk throughout the viewing and if items are not collected at the stated time.
- 16. Participant's names should not be written around/on the rangoli or displayed in any manner whatsoever.
- 17. **This event is Open to All**. (Participants from all communities and backgrounds are permitted to participate)

- 3. The size should be around 12'
- 4. Materials to be brought by participants
- 5. Judgment will be made 80 % Thali and 20% presentation.
- 6. As this is on the spot competition pre-done and pre-prepared work will be observed and pointed out to the judges.
- 7. Open to all
- 8. All thalis are at the participants' risk throughout the viewing of the exhibition and if not collected at the stated time.
- 9. Participant's names should not be written on the thali or displayed in any manner whatsoever.

MITHAI BOX COMPETITION

AGES	TIME ALLOWED
12-16	3 hours
16 years and above	3 hours

- 1. Must assemble the box on the spot. Allowed to bring cut out.
- 2. Can be any shape as long as it measure between 10' inches to 8'inches length by breath
- 3. Has to be strong enough to fill with Mithai or chocolates.
- 4. Time 3 hours
- 5. Participants exceeding time limit will be penalized not disqualified.
- 6. As this is an on-the-spot competition, pre-done and pre-prepared work will be observed by the organizers and pointed out to the judges and can be penalized. Reference to sketches is allowed.
- 7. All materials should be brought by the participants.
- 8. All paint effects must dry by the end of the time allowed.
- 9. Boxes, Decorations or any other items not collected on the 7th November 2015 before 5.00pm shall be disposed off by the organizers and the organizers or any member of the Women's Wing of the Oshwal Youth League shall hold no responsibility of the same
- 10. All boxes are at the participants' risk throughout the viewing of the exhibition and if not collected at the stated time.
